### **Expenses**

#1 - \$50 due Thursday, August 1st

#2 - \$50 due Friday, September 6th

IFA Fundraising credits may be used to pay expense payments, but cannot be used to pay for the marching shoes or the shirt.

### **What You Need To Supply**

### **Fundraisers & IFA**

All members are required to participate in any group fundraisers we have. There will be several fundraising opportunities for students to raise funds for their IFA (Individual Financial Account). Fundraising credits that are credited to a student's IFA may be used to pay for any of the expense payments, but not for the marching shoes and shirt payments. If a student raises more funds than they owe, the amount can carry over to next year. When a student graduates, if they have credits remaining in their account, it can be transferred to a sibling that lives in the same home. If they do not have a sibling in the same home the credits are transferred to the general music department account at Bremen H.S.
